

Steps for Foreign License Validation Application

By following the steps in this document, you will get a letter from the FAA with a background check. It is a very simple process and there is no cost.

You will receive the letter within 4-6 weeks and that will allow to get a private pilot based on your foreign license and to get your instrument flight test and commercial.

STEP 1: Fill Out The Online Application

Go online and fill out and print application.

- ❖ To access the application form, you must go to this web address:
<http://registry.faa.gov/docs/verify61-75.pdf>
- ❖ On **block 10** of the application, it will ask for "Local FSDO" information. Use the following information: **Miami FSDO 19 8600 NW 36TH**

STEP 2: What Do I Need To Send?

In order to receive your FAA certificate you must send ALL of following to:

- ❖ **A copy of your foreign airman certificate.**
- ❖ **A copy of FAA issued medical certificate.**
- ❖ **A copy of your Foreign License Revalidation application filled out in its entirety.**
- ❖ **A copy of an OFFICIAL translation of your airman certificate.**

Note: This is only required if your airman certificate is NOT in English. If your certificate needs to be translated, we recommend the services of:
