When choosing a Flight School, a complete comparison of ALL school costs is CRITICAL



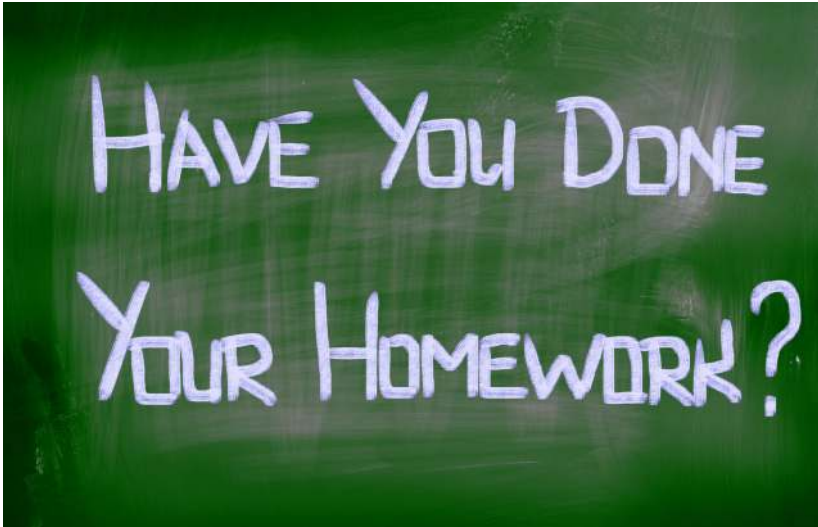
There are an incredible number of Flight Schools to choose from these days. This is to be expected since demand for Air-line Pilots will grow at an enormous rate over the next few years. While this is not necessarily bad, it detracts from the purpose of flight training, which is to study hard, train like a pro, and succeed in the world of aviation. **That’s why we do not believe in internships.** Instead, ADF gives you block discounts for advance payments and will only ask that you focus on your training so you can graduate on time and under budget. Who wants to study after spending 4 to 5 hours cleaning or fueling airplanes?



Researching all the flight schools out there is a major task, but it’s better than getting to a school and throwing your money (and time) away.

- How many airplanes does the school have?
- Do you have to pay for the entire course in advance?
- What percentage of the school's graduates get hired?
